



GOA01T - PORTOFINO (approx. 4 hours) - Genoa, Italy

Thanks to its mild climate, charming old fishing ports and beautiful countryside, the Italian Riviera has been a popular holiday destination since Byron and Shelley's day. This tour gives you a chance to enjoy a lush section of this famous coastline and begins with a 45-minute coach ride to Santa Margherita Ligure, a pretty fishing village. A further 10 minutes by coach then takes you to Portofino. You will have plenty of time to explore this delightful seaside town at your leisure, to take photos, visit the seafront or simply to relax in one of the many chic seafront cafés. Your return journey to Santa Margherita will be by boat, after which you will return to Genoa and to the ship by coach.

At the end the visit, no rush to return back to the ship. Passengers will take their time to enjoy the town and return by shuttle bus departing every 30 minutes from the Aquarium drop on.

MRS02 - AIX-EN-PROVENCE (approx. 4 hours) - Marseille, France

MRS07WI - AVIGNON AND MARSEILLES (full day, lunch not included) - Marseille, France
